The petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 17.05.2025, Annexure P-17, passed by the Executing Court directing the petitioner/judgment debtor to deposit the decretal amount of ₹3.75 crore by way of FDR in a Nationalised Bank or by way of Bank Guarantee which is due in terms of Award dated 18.05.2017.

2. It is not disputed that the petitioner has already challenged the judgment passed by the Additional District Judge/Commercial Court, Chandigarh, dated 24.07.2023, dismissing objections against the Award, by filing appeal FAO-CARB-52-2023, which is pending adjudication before a Division Bench at motion stage.

3. Since the Division Bench is seized of the issue in the aforesaid appeal, this Court is not inclined to entertain the petition which has been filed impugning the order passed by the Executing Court for enforcement of the award against which petitioner's appeal is already pending.

4. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to make appropriate application before the Division Bench.
