**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)**

1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101, dated 10.05.2021, under Section 302 of IPC (Sections 380, 411 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

2. Learned State counsel, at the outset, has submitted that the trial is nearing conclusion with one 01 prosecution witness remain to be examined. He has further submitted that the prosecution witnesses have supported the case of the prosecution.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to dispute the instructions received by learned counsel for the State with respect to the stage of trial and also with respect to the prosecution witnesses having supported the case of the prosecution in its entirety. However, he has

submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material placed on record.

5. The trial is near conclusion and, therefore, in the facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner for releasing him on bail at this stage.

6. Present petition stands dismissed accordingly.

7. However, it is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
