1. The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of directions passed on 06.11.2024 in CRM-M-54782 of 2024 vide which the Investigating Agency was directed to conclude the investigation in FIR No. 43, dated 10.07.2024, under Sections 452, 325, 326 and 34 IPC, Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala, expeditiously.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Karnail Singh, Sub Division, Bholath, District Kapurthala, submits that investigation stands completed and the Investigating Agency is in the process of filing a cancellation report.

3. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. The petitioner may, however, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law.

The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
