2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the interim order dated 09.07.2024 passed in CWP No.10232 of 2015, the order dated 27.09.2024 (Annexure P-11) has been passed by the respondents hence, the claim of the petitioners be also considered by the respondents in terms of the said order.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate speaking order on the claim of the petitioners will be passed within a period of eight weeks keeping in view the relief granted vide order dated 27.09.2024 (Annexure P-11) and in case, the petitioners are also found entitled for the same relief, the same will be granted to them otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
