Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 4 to release all the retiral benefits of the petitioner alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that due to inadvertence, respondent No.3-District Food and Supplies and Consumer Affairs Controller, Jind has been impleaded as a party instead of District Food and Supplies and Consumer Affairs Controller, Panchkula. He also places on record the amended memo of parties in the Court today, which is taken on record.

Registry is directed to scan the same and tag an appropriate place.



After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.3-District Food and Supplies and Consumer Affairs Controller, Panchkula is directed to consider the claim of the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vikrant Pamboo, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.3 to treat this petition as a representation and take appropriate steps for disbursement of the retiral benefits of the petitioner within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that if upon considering the said representation, in case any monetary benefit is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in his favour within the aforesaid period, failing which the petitioner shall be entitled to interest at 7% per annum.
