1. At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondent submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as, the order dated 09.05.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-22931-2017 and another connected writ petition bearing CWP-22932-2017, stands recalled by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 29.01.2025, passed in application bearing Nos.
