Appellant-defendants No. 1 and 2 are in second appeal against the order dated 23.07.2013, passed by the learned lower Appellate Court, remanding the case back to the trial Court to decide the matter afresh.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 24.03.2025, when this case was listed for hearing along with connected appeal bearing RSA-5887-2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

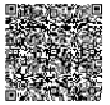
“Learned counsel for respondents No. 1 & 2 (through LR's) submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Even today, learned counsel for the appellants submits that he has no instructions regarding any alleged compromise between the parties. However, learned counsel appearing for the LR's of respondents



No. 1 and 2 has handed over in Court a copy of Compromise dated 02.04.2023, entered into between the parties, which is taken on record and annexed with the connected appeal.

A copy thereof, has also been handed over to learned counsel for the appellants.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present appeal; and the same is **disposed of** as having been rendered infructuous. However, in case anything survives liberty is granted to the appellants to move an appropriate application within a period of 03 months from today for reviving the same, if so, advised.
