Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying with the order dated 14.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-26219-2024 titled as “Ram Phal vs. State of Haryana and others”, vide which the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the State that “...the appeal shall be decided within a period of three months after granting him an opportunity of hearing as also taking into account the aforesaid judgments, which he may produce during that time.”

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order



dated 08.7.2025 by the competent authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 08.7.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner(s). Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.
