1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for the issuance of a direction upon the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation on the complaint bearing No. UID:320438 dated 15.3.2024 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner. A further prayer has been made for the issuance of directions upon the official respondents to register an FIR against the private respondents under the appropriate provisions of law.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed the representation dated 24.3.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No. 2 raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to the respondents concerned to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon.



3. Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage only.
4. At the asking of the Court, Ms. Guramrit Kaur, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to her during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner expeditiously and within a time bound manner, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
