AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5

Mr. Ankur Gupta, Advocate put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3-Insurance Company and has filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

The appeal stands settled at Rs.21,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of proposal form dated 09.07.2025 duly signed by both the parties.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs. 21,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lacs Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant No.1-Lalita Sharma with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 6 weeks of this order. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
