Challenge in the present petition is to the selection process and the final result dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-9) declared by respondent No.2 vide Advertisement No.16 of 2024 dated 21.06.2024 for the post of Ayurvedic Medical Officer (Group-B) in Health & Ayush Department, Haryana, with a further prayer for directing respondent No.2 to declare and disclose the result of screening test of the petitioner.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-10) but the respondents have neither responded to the same nor have they taken any action thereupon till date.

At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner contends that due to oversight and inadvertence, he has impleaded 'Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula' as respondent No.2 whereas the actual contesting

party is 'Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula'. He makes an oral request to allow him to amend the Memo of Parties accordingly.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that she has no objection to the Memo of Parties being amended. She, however, prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary.

In view of the above, the request of counsel for the petitioner to amend the Memo of Parties is allowed and he is permitted to carry out necessary changes in the Memo of Parties. He is further directed to file the Amended Memo of Parties with the Registry of this Court during the course of the day.

At this stage, Mr. Gurnoor Sandhu, Advocate enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the newly added respondent No.2-Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if so advised.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2- Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-10) submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel for respondent No.2 does not have any objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition

is disposed of while directing respondent No.2 – Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-10) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of two months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
