Petitioner alleges violation of judgment dated 20.05.2015, passed in RSA No.2282 of 1990. According to him, entire payment, as directed by the court, has not been released to the petitioner.

Stand of the State is that after taking into account the ad hoc service rendered by the petitioner, the amount has been calculated. Interest has also been paid @ 9%. Thus, the judgment stands complied with.

Learned State counsel has also produced the record to apprise the court about the manner, in which calculation has been made.

Under the circumstances, this contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and dismissed as such. Rule is discharged.
