1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner – Kuljit Singh, seeking issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4, not to call and harass him, time and again in their offices/police stations on the false and frivolous complaint made by respondent No.5, as civil and criminal dispute between both the parties is going on before the learned Courts below.

2. It is brought to the notice of this Court that petitioner and his wife, namely Parwinder Kaur, are facing proceedings, arising out of the registration of FIR No.195 dated 15.09.2023, under Sections 354-A, 342, 506, 509, 323, and 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala. In addition, Parwinder Kaur, who is wife of the petitioner, is also a plaintiff in a civil suit filed by respondent No.5. Said civil suit, pertaining to the possession of a house, is presently pending before the Courts at Sultanpur Lodhi.

3. It has been alleged that police officials have been making phone calls to the petitioner, unnecessarily summoning him to the police station.

4. This Court has gone through the facts mentioned in the present petition, and does not find any justifiable ground to issue any direction to the official respondents, at this stage.

5. Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.
