1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0065 dated 11.05.2025, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 191(3) and 190 of BNS, 2023 (lateron added Section 117(2) of BNS), registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.
2. Vide order dated 19.08.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 19.08.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



5. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. In view of the above, interim order dated 19.08.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.
7. Petition stands allowed.
