SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the office letter memo No.1126 dated 01.04.2024, Annexure P9 and speaking order/office order No.41 dated 31.01.2022, Annexure P6. Further prayer has been made seeking direction to respondents to pay the compensation to the tune of Rs.50 lakhs along with 9% interest from the date of accident.

2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was the position on the previous three occasions. Counsel for the respondents points out that petitioner has failed to comply with order

dated 06.05.2024 passed by this Court. Court has been informed that although a request was received for appearance of counsel for petitioner through the virtual mode, but counsel has not joined the proceedings.

3. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the petition.

4. Dismissed in default for non-prosecution.
