VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (Oral):

1. The grievance of the petitioner in the instant contempt petition is the non-compliance of the directions issued in CWP-16998-2009 on 17.07.2017.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh.Parvinder, Under Secretary Revenue, submits that the requisite documents were not submitted by the legal representative of Krishna Devi, as a result of which, the allotment could not be made.
3. In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, at the first instance, would approach the respondent with a view to complete all the necessary formalities and, therefore, he does not press the contempt petition, at this stage.
