1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.431 dated 17.12.2024 under Sections 125, 109, 3(5) of BNS, 2023 read with Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 29.01.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that present petition has not been filed on behalf of all the stake-holders, as such, the same is not maintainable in terms of the judgment rendered by the Division Bench of this Court.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that fresh compromise has taken place between the parties and she has instructions to file a fresh petition on the basis of fresh compromise.
