SHALINI SINGH NAGPAL J. (Oral)

1. In the petition under Section 528, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (B.N.S.S.) 2023, the prayer is for quashing FIR No.0080 dated 14.12.2021 under Sections 323, 498-A, 406, 34 IPC, registered in Women Police Station Hansi, District Hansi and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 12.12.2024 effected between the parties.
2. Reply by way of affidavit on behalf of respondent No.1-State of Haryana has been filed, which is taken on record.
3. On 18.12.2024, this Court directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of their statements with regard to compromise dated 12.12.2024 within two weeks from 18.12.2024 or any other date convenient to the Court.
4. In compliance of the aforesaid order, parties appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Hansi on 09.01.2025. Statement of the Investigating Officer, ASI Nanhi was also recorded on 09.01.2025. Learned JMFC, Hansi has submitted his report recording satisfaction that all the parties

have entered into a valid compromise without any influence or coercion.

No accused is proclaimed offender in this case.

5. Learned State counsel and counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 have not raised any dispute regarding the factum of compromise. The genesis of the dispute is a matrimonial discord. Since the matter has been amicably resolved, continuation of the criminal proceedings would be an exercise in futility.

6. Following principles of law laid down by the Full Bench Judgment of this Court in ***“Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another”*** 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and Hon’ble Supreme Court in ***“Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others”*** (2012) 10 SCC 303, the petition is allowed.

7. FIR No.0080 dated 14.12.2021 under 323, 498-A, 406, 34 IPC, registered in Women Police Station Hansi, District Hansi and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner.
