1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.2 & 3 to transfer the inquiry, which is pending with respondent No.4, initiated with respect of the complaint submitted by private respondents No.6 & 7 against the petitioner and one Narinder Kumar son of Phul Kumar. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to handover the inquiry of the aforesaid complaint to an officer not below the rank of S.P. in order to ensure that the inquiry of the case be conducted in a fair, impartial and proper manner and for directing respondents No.2 & 3 to handover the inquiry to some independent agency or special investigation team for proper and impartial inquiry.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the redressal of her grievances, the petitioner has already filed her



representation dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) before respondents No.2 & 3, but no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. He submits that representation filed by the petitioner dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) would be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, Punjab to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by her.
