The petitioner apprehending the arrest in the FIR captioned above, has come up before this Court under Section 482 BNSS seeking anticipatory bail.

2. In para 13 of the bail petition, the petitioner claims that he has no criminal antecedents.

3. Status report dated 04.05.2025 filed by State counsel today in the Court is taken on record. However, State counsel submits that as per status report, one another FIR No. 45/2019 under Sections 353/186 IPC, PS Jhander, Amritsar Rural is pending against the petitioner.

4. Since, the petitioner has concealed the criminal history, therefore, the present petition is dismissed for concealment. Petitioner shall be at liberty to file fresh petition after disclosing all criminal antecedents including the cases, in which petitioner has been convicted and the cases as mentioned in the status report. It is clarified that there shall be no need to mention those cases in which cancellation report have been filed and petitioner is discharged or acquitted. It is clarified that while filing fresh petition, filing and dismissal of present petition shall not come in the way of petitioner. All pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
