This is an application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 14 days in filing the appeal.

Keeping in view the facts mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 14 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

1. In the present appeal, the challenge is to the order dated 30.07.2025 passed in CWP-21676-2025 titled as *Paramjit Kaur and others vs. Financial Commissioner, Punjab and others* by the learned Single Judge by which, the petition filed by the appellants for setting aside the order dated 19.05.2025 passed by the learned Financial Commissioner, Punjab, was dismissed and the Assistant Collector was directed to conclude the partition proceedings within a period of ten months.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants submits that though, while passing the order in review dated 04.09.2025 in RA-CW-388-2025, in paragraph 5, it has been mentioned that all the pleas available to the appellants will be raised before the Assistant Collector Grade-I, but it was not clarified that the plea of the Civil Court decree can also be taken.

3. Qua the said argument, it may noticed that the word “all pleas” means that any plea which will be taken by the appellants, will be taken into consideration by the Assistant Collector for deciding the matter.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the appellants submits that the present appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to raise all the pleas before the Assistant Collector Grade-I.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
