Present petition has been filed under Section 340 read with Section 195 (1) (b) of Criminal Procedure Code (now Section 379 read with Section 215 of BNSS) for passing an order for directing to file a complaint for the offence of perjury (U/S 191 of I.P.C.), knowingly filed false affidavit, to vacate the stay order as Annexure 'P/5' before the Court of Hon'ble Mr. Justice A.L.
