Discussed.

A statement made on behalf of the cross-objectors/claimants that in full and final satisfaction of their claim, an amount of Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lacs Only) over and above the amount awarded by the tribunal be awarded and be disbursed to the claimants/cross-objectors in the same ratio as apportioned by the learned MACT having been accepted on behalf of the insurer of the offending vehicle, the cross-objections are disposed of with a direction to the insurer to deposit with the office of the Lok Adalat a cheque in the sum of Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lacs Only), favouring the claimants/cross-objectors in the same ratio as apportioned by the learned MACT within two months from today, failing which the amount hereby awarded shall carry interest @ 9% per annum from the date of this order till payment thereof.

The cheques so deposited may be collected by the above-named claimants/cross-objectors or the counsel representing the claimants against proper receipt.

Miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.

A copy of this order be made available to each of the appearing counsel, and file be consigned.

FAO-7668-2014 (O&M) (Main Case)

Connected appeal i.e., FAO-7668-2014 has been settled by way of compromise.

In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties in connected appeal i.e. FAO-7668-2014, learned counsel for the

Insurance Company, states that the Company does not press this appeal and prays that the same may be dismissed as not pressed.

So ordered.

Registry to refund an amount of Rs.25,000/- deposited by the appellant at the time of filing of the appeal.
