The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS in case bearing FIR No.143 dated 27.09.2023 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station City-I Malerkotla, District Malerkotla.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.02.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 24.02.2025 by way of an affidavit of Kuldeep Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State.
