1. Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly states that the issue raised in the present writ-petition stands already adjudicated by the Supreme Court in the case of *Bijender Singh vs. Union of India and others, 2025 INSC 549* wherein the Apex Court has reaffirmed the judgment passed in the case of *Union of India vs. Ram Avtar in Civil Appeal No.418 of 2012 decided on 10.12.2014* to apply to all cases.

2. In view thereto, the rounding off 65% disability to 75% is found to be in accordance with law. The challenge to the order passed by AFT dated 06.09.2023 is without any merit and the present writ-petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

3. It is noticed that the UOI is not implementing the orders of the AFT for years together. We, therefore, direct that the order be implemented



possibly within a period of two months from today, failing which, the concerned aggrieved person would be free to approach this Court for initiating contempt proceedings against the concerned persons, who would be personally liable.
