Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the impugned action of official respondents, whereby the separate property ID of the petitioner as detailed in para No.3 of this writ petition, has been changed and mixed up with property ID No.7X4BQV64 i.e., 2813.25 sq. yard.

1.1. A further prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus*, for directing respondent No.4 to consider the

representation dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-5) and reminder dated 08.01.2025 (Annexure P-6), submitted by the petitioner.

2. On 18.03.2025, the following order was passed:-

*“Mr. Jagdish Manchanda, Advocate appears and files Power of Attorney on behalf of respondent No.5 in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. He informs the Court that respondent No.6 (Ranjit Singh) has already filed a Civil Suit before the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ratia, wherein interim order dated 21.02.2025 has been passed. A copy thereof is handed over in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Another copy has also been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, in Court today itself, who seeks an accommodation to get further instructions and assist the Court in this matter.*

*At his request, adjourned to 24.03.2025.”*

3. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition at this stage so as to enable the petitioner to contest the civil suit filed against him and to file a fresh writ petition, if need so arise.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
