Prayer in the present petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 30.7.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRWP-7268-2024 titled as "Mohinder Pal vs. State of Punjab and others", vide which the respondent was directed "*....to consider the representation dated 05.6.2024 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today.*"

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has filed the short Reply/Compliance Report dated 09.8.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri Sandeep Kumar Malik, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and submits that necessary compliance has been made.



Learned counsel refers to the Compliance Report (Annexure R-1/T annexed with the reply and submits that the present contempt petition is not maintainable.

Copy of the aforesaid Reply dated 09.8.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Learned counsel for the State undertakes to supply copy of the said Reply to learned counsel for the petitioner. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.
