1. The present review application has been filed under Order 47 Rule 1 CPC read with Section 151 CPC for review of the order dated 20.09.2022 passed by this Court in an appeal being RSA-5778-2019. The appeal was dismissed vide a detailed order passed by this Court on 20.09.2022. Aggrieved by the same, the review applicant herein preferred a Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) No.23493-2022 which was dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 04.01.2023. Still not satisfied, the review applicant herein filed a Review Petition (Civil) No.712-2023 in Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) No.23493-2022 which was also dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide order dated 01.11.2023 and the following order was passed :

'1. Application for oral hearing of the review petition is dismissed.

2. Having perused the review petition, there is no error apparent on the face of the record. No case for review under Order XLVII Rule 1 of the Supreme Court Rules, 2013. The review petition is, therefore, dismissed.

3. Pending application, if any, stand disposed of.

2. Yet again, despite the review petition being Review Petition (Civil) No.712-2023 having been dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the review applicant herein was not satisfied and preferred a Curative Petition which was also dismissed, as stated in the review application itself (though the order has not been appended with the review application). Now the present review application has been filed before this Court for review of the order dated 20.09.2022 passed by this Court.

3. At the outset, on realizing that the Court is not agreeing to the submissions made by him and is inclined to impose heavy costs, learned counsel for the review applicant seeks permission to withdraw the present review application.

4. Review application stands dismissed as withdrawn. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed off.
