Prayer in this application filed under Section 151 CPC is for placing on record mutual compromise dated 15.02.2025; and the General Power of Attorney dated 23.02.2023 on behalf of appellant No. 3- Amanpreet Kaur as Annexure A-1 and A-2, respectively.

Notice of the application.

Mr. Inderpal Singh, Advocate who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 8; whereas on the asking of Court, Mr. Manmeet Singh Teji, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 9 to 12. Both learned counsel for the respondents have pleaded 'no objection' in case, the present application is allowed.

In view of the above and for the reasons mentioned in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is **allowed**;



and mutual compromise dated 15.02.2025; and the General Power of Attorney dated 23.02.2023 on behalf of appellant No. 3-Amanpreet Kaur are taken on record as Annexure A-1 and A-2, respectively.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the entire disputes which are the subject matter of this second appeal stand settled between the parties by way of mutual compromise dated 15.02.2025 (Annexure A-1); and the present second appeal may be accepted. It is further prayed that the impugned judgments and decrees of both the Courts below i.e. dated 26.11.2008 passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Zira and 15.03.2012, passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Ferozpur, may also be set aside.

In view of the above and for the reasons mentioned in the application (CM-2307-C-2025), the same is allowed; and the main second appeal (RSA-3914-2012) is **accepted** in terms of in terms of compromise (Annexure A-1) arrived at between the parties.
