**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J.(ORAL)**

In compliance with the order passed by this Court dated 30.11.2011 (Annexure P-1), an affidavit dated 26.09.2014 of Shri J.S. Aulakh, Deputy Secretary (Freedom Fighter), Government of Punjab, Department of General Administration, has been filed in Court, according to which, the District Treasury Officer, Patiala has certified that the arrears of pension amounting to ₹2,28,720/- and interest of ₹1,56,906/- have been credited to the account of Shri Sohan Singh having PPO No.8364/SS/Pb, account No.33052054892, on 18.9.2014.

In the light of the above affidavit, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition, in case, affidavit is found to be incorrect.

At this stage, counsel for the State submits that in case, some dues are left out which the petitioner is entitled to, he may make a representation to the deponent, who have filed the affidavit today in the Court which shall be duly considered and decided within a period of two months from the date of submission of such representation and if any amount is still found due, the same shall be released to him within a further period of one month.

The Rule stands discharged in view of the above.
