1. Present civil revision has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 24.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Malerkotla, whereby application under Sections 5 & 8 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 filed by the defendant/respondent has been allowed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the plaint in the present case has been returned in view of the arbitration clause and the petitioner is at liberty to invoke the said clause, thus, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to get an Arbitrator appointed and also with liberty to move an application under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for interim stay.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
