NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant criminal revision petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the impugned order dated 31.10.2022 passed by the learned Family Court, Panipat whereby a sum of Rs.75,000/- per month has been awarded as maintenance to respondent No.1-wife under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

2. On 02.02.2024, the following order was passed:-

“Affidavit of the petitioner dated 01.02.2024 has been filed in Court which is taken on record, as per which the deponent has paid maintenance to the tune of Rs.19,55,000/- out of total amount of Rs.78,75,000/-.

Copy of the Income Tax Returns(ITR's) for the last three years prior to the decision by the Family Court, Panipat be placed on record.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, it is a fit case to make reference to mediation.

Notice of motion for mediation process, at this stage for 20.03.2024 subject to the condition that costs of Rs. 50,000/- as litigation expenses by way of a demand draft, be deposited by the



petitioner in the Registry of this Court, within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be handed over to respondent No. 1 by the learned Mediator, when she appears before him.

The petitioner and respondent No.1 would appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 20.03.2024.

Adjourned to 11.07.2024 for awaiting the report of the Mediator.

In the meantime, petitioner would continue paying the monthly amount awarded by the Family Court, Panipat.

3. Since the aforesaid order was not complied with, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought one week's time on 16.01.2025 for compliance of order dated 02.02.2024 but till today, the same has not been complied with.
4. Learned proxy counsel for the petitioner pleads no instructions.
5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
