Prayer in this petition is for taking action against the respondents for disregarding the order dated 23.1.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Criminal Writ Petition No.12186 of 2024.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage limits his prayer and submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondent No.1-Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to consider and take a final decision on representation dated 10.2.2025 (Annexure P-3) made by the petitioner in a time bound manner.
