Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Gurjeet Singh, Legal Assistant, Transport Department, who is present in Court, submits that speaking order, with respect to the claim of petitioner in terms of order dated 28.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Writ Court, shall be passed within one week from today and copy thereof will be forwarded to the petitioner soon thereafter.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /

concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
