This is a petition filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya  
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS), seeking direction to  
respondents No. 1 to 6 to take legal action against respondents-accused  
No. 7 to 19 in case FIR as mentioned below: -

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Kumar Gujjar, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 6 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.

6. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, District Gurugram, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 26.10.2024 (Annexure P-20) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

7. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
