1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 23.09.2022 passed in CWP-22022-2022.
2. Affidavit of Priyank Bharti, IAS, Secretary to Government of Punjab, Public Works Department (B & R), Branch, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 23.09.2022 passed in CWP-22022-2022 has been complied with and the appeal filed by the petitioner has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 20.11.2023 (Annexure R-1).
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
