1. Learned counsel for the parties submits that the parties have amicably resolved their dispute and as per the said agreement, the petitioner will pay a sum of Rs.5,000/- instead of Rs.10,000/- per month to the respondent No.3-mother from the date it was ordered by the Tribunal vide impugned order dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P/2) to be paid by the petitioner to the respondent No.3-mother along with arrears.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that henceforth also by the 7th of every month, a sum of Rs.5000/- will be deposited by the petitioner in the bank account of respondent No.3-mother without any fail.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.3 has accepted the said

fact keeping in view the fact that respondent No.3-mother is also present in Court, who accepted the offer of the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the agreement between the parties, present petition is disposed of and the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.5000/- per month in the bank account of respondent No.3-mother from the date the same was ordered by the Tribunal vide impugned order dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P/2) along with arrears within a period of 06 weeks from today. Further, the petitioner will keep on depositing a sum of Rs.5000/- by the 7th of every month in the bank account of respondent No.3-mother failure of which will make the petitioner bound by the terms and conditions of the impugned order dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P/2).

5. Present petition is disposed in above terms.
