The present petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in NCB Crime No.44 dated 21.06.2022, under Section(s) 8, 21 and 23 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jalalabad.

Counsel appearing for the respondent-NCB contends that 13 out of 19 witnesses have already been examined and the next date fixed for recording of remaining evidence before the trial Court is 29.10.2025. He contends that the prosecution shall conclude its entire evidence within a period of three months from the next date fixed before the trial Court.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed at this stage.

State counsel shall ensure that the prosecution evidence is concluded within the time frame as undertaken today.
