**AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):**

1. Learned counsel representing petitioners states that in the prayer clause it is wrongly prayed for quashing of FIR, in fact cancellation report is already submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate and it is pending for disposal. The petitioner intended to file direction matter for expeditious disposal of the cancellation petition already pending before Illaqa Magistrate, therefore, at this stage, he has instructions to withdraw present petition for quashing of FIR No.207, dated 27.11.2021, under Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act 1956, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Bathinda (Annexure P-1) and he will seek appropriate remedy, as per law.
