Short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Priyank Bharti, Administrative Secretary, Government of Punjab, Department of Forest and Wildlife Preservation, Punjab filed in the Court today is taken on record.

2. By way of the instant contempt petition, the petitioners allege willful disobedience of order dated 19.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-13481-2022.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there were two claims of the petitioners i.e. the grant of Old Pension Scheme to the petitioners and regularization with effect from the date their juniors were promoted.

4. At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the claim of the petitioners as regards the grant of Old Pension Scheme, has been accepted and GPF numbers have been allotted to them. However, the second claim as regards regularization with effect from the date their juniors were allegedly promoted has been rejected by way of order dated 13.08.2025 (Annexure R-5).



5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as regards the second claim, the petitioners shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law.

6. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
