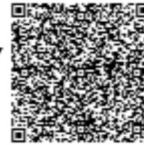
**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)**

The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.281 dated 23.12.2024 registered under Sections 109, 125, 194(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act registered at P.S. Sadar, Amritsar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 23.06.2025 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 23.06.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 23.06.2025 is made absolute.
