**JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (Oral)**

1. The present Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking directions to the learned Additional District Judge, Jalandhar, for expeditious disposal of the application under Section 36(2) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act'), filed in the objection petition under Section 34 of the Act, which is pending adjudication.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 25.08.2025, a status report was called for from the concerned learned Additional District Judge, with regard to the status of the stay application.

3. Today, a report dated 23.09.2025 has been received from the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, wherein it has been stated that the matter is now fixed for arguments on 19.11.2025.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner-NHAI submitted that his prayer in the present petition is only to a limited extent for expeditious disposal of the aforesaid application under Section 36(2) of the Act.

5. Considering the aforesaid status report submitted by the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar and the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner-NHAI, the present Revision Petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned learned Court, before whom the application under Section 36(2) of the Act is pending, to decide the same as expeditiously as possible and strictly in accordance with law.
