The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to keep departmental proceedings in abeyance till the conclusion of trial arising out of FIR No.26 dated 04.10.2022 under Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, P.S. SVB, Ambala.

2. Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana submits that petitioner has been acquitted in afore-stated FIR by judgment dated 30.01.2025 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal. Thus, instant petition has rendered infructuous.

3. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the State, instant petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file an application for revival within 3 months from today, if cause survives.
