The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered against him vide FIR No.12 dated 16.04.2025 under Sections 7/7A/13 of PC Act, at Police Station ACB, Gurugram, District Gurugram (Haryana).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.08.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 16.09.2025 by way of an affidavit of Ashok Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Anti Corruption Bureau, Gurugram has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the

aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 18.08.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
