The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to re-induct the petitioner in service who was working as part-time Lecturer in Sanskrit in the fourth respondent-School.

2. It is apparent from the record that the petitioner's service was terminated vide order dated 28.02.2000, Annexure R-4/2. It was on account of the post having been abolished by the Government as the strength of students had not increased as expected. As per endorsement dated 28.02.2000, the termination letter was received by the petitioner but he refused to sign the same. Since the petitioner has not challenged the order of termination, the relief claimed cannot be granted.

3. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed.
