SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This petition has been filed by a financial institution against non-execution of order dated 17.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) passed by Additional District Magistrate, Barnala, under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that a fresh notice has now been issued by Tehsildar, Barnala, for handing over physical possession of the secured asset(s) to the petitioner on 08.08.2025.

3. In view of the above, this Court disposes of the petition with a direction to District Magistrate, Barnala, as well as Tehsildar, Barnala, to hand over physical possession of secured asset(s) on the said date to the petitioner, provided there is no other legal impediment of any restraint order passed by any judicial authority.
