Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023, seeking setting aside of the order dated 23.11.2024 (P-4) passed by respondent No. 4, insofar as respondent No. 4 declined parole to the petitioner for attending the Bhat ceremony of his cousin sister (Bua's daughter), which was scheduled to be solemnized on 02.12.2024.

ii) In view of the fact that the ceremony on 02.12.2024 has already taken place, and the petitioner has since been granted parole in a separate writ petition, namely CRWP-11591-2024, prayer made in the present petition has become infructuous.

iii) Accordingly, present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
