1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nyaya Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for quashing of order dated 13.08.2025 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala in case arising out of FIR No.0054 dated 01.03.2025, under Sections 109(1), 190, 191(3), 238 and 249 of BNS, 2023 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala, whereby his bail bonds were cancelled by learned trial Court and surety bonds were forfeited to the State andailable warrants have been ordered to be issued against him.

2. It is argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the trial Court but only on 13.08.2025 he could not appear as he noted down the date 13.09.2025 instead of 13.08.2025. He is out of station being taxi driver. Hence, his counsel could not contact him. He is ready to join proceedings before the trial Court. His absence was not intentional. Therefore, he has submitted that

the present petition deserves to be allowed.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Shaveta Sanghi, learned DAG, Haryana accepts notice and submits that there is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned order, therefore, the prayer made in the petition deserves to be rejected.

5. Perusal of record reveals that the petitioner has been regularly appearing before the trial Court and only on 13.08.2025, due to his non-appearance, warrants have been issued against him by learned trial Court. His absence is not intentional. Therefore, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and on his surrender, he shall be admitted on bail by learned trial Court subject to his furnishing fresh personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court and in case of his failure to do so, this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
