1. Present petition has been filed for seeking fair investigation of the FIR No.34 dated 11.02.2019 registered under Section 21/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act at Police Station Civil Lines Amritsar, District Amritsar with a further prayer to transfer the investigation to respondent No.2-CBI in view of the fact that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR, along with certain other prayers.

2. It has been submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had earlier approached this court by way of filing CRM-M-27776-2024, which has been disposed of vide order dated 11.07.2024. It is submitted that the accused in the present case are the police officials and hence the investigating agencies are not intentionally completing the investigation. He submits that the officer of the rank of AIG and DSP are accused and hence they are intentionally not being arrested.

3. Notice of motion to State of Punjab only.



4. Mr. Jastej Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and has submitted on instructions from Bikram Jit Singh, DSP, ANTF, Jalandhar, that in all there are 07 accused, out of which two have been declared proclaimed offenders whereas out of remaining 05 the challan has already been presented against 04 of the accused and charges are also framed. He submits that 5<sup>th</sup> accused is respondent No.24-Rashpal Singh Ex-AIG qua whom the investigation is already in progress. He submits that the investigation is pending to await the report from the handwriting expert. He submits that the investigation would be completed within two months from today.

5. In view of the above submissions made by counsel for the State, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating agency to complete the investigation in a free and fair manner within a period of two months from today, in accordance with law. The petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedies, in case any further cause of action accrues.
