Petitioner seeks a direction to respondent No. 2, to carry out fair and impartial investigation in case arising out of FIR No. 0039 dated 16.03.2025 under Sections 137(2), 96 Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar and to decide his representation dated 18.06.2025 in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was the father of one Shiva Paswan, accused in FIR No. 39 dated 16.03.2025 under Sections 137(2), 96 Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar. He further submits that no offence was committed by son of the petitioner as the prosecutrix was a major girl, more than 18 years of age and had gone with petitioner's son, of her free will and thereafter, solemnized marriage with him.
